Fertility of a soil is defined as its ability to supply the essential plant nutrients in a quantity and rate required by a crop.

## *Methodology:*

and the addition of non xenobiotic substances.**

To create the soil environment and condition necessary to cause the natural soil organisms to break dormancy and to feed and stimulate their growth to enable them to complete their natural life cycles.

## *Sustainability:*

**To produce a bountiful harvest  
with a positive residual effect for the following crop**

True sustainability is achieved when the natural soil fertility attains a higher level each successive year.
